Give your child the best start possible before Kindergarten begins by making sure he or she is able to:

- Hold and use a pencil, scissor and crayons correctly.
- Recognize and verbally communicate first and last name.
- Write first name with only the first letter capitalized, i.e. Sam not SAM.
- Identify colors and basic shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle).
- Recognize numbers 0-10.
- Count aloud from one to 20.
- Recite the alphabet.
- Recognize capital and lowercase letters in random order.

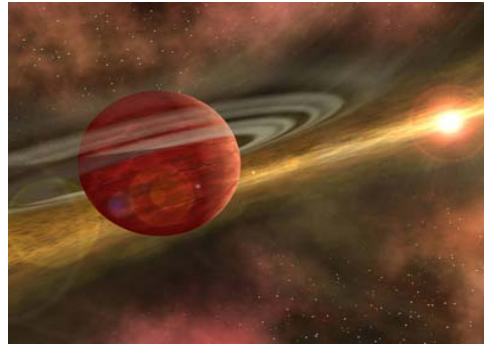
